# **Description**

This document describes the additional supporting files that accompany the 'Apprenticeships: November 2025' accredited official statistics publication. This data is released under the terms of the Open Government License. It is provided to allow users to interrogate the data themselves.

The underlying data files contain apprenticeship starts, achievements and participation figures in England; broken down by learner characteristics (e.g. age, sex, ethnicity group), geography (e.g. region, local authority district) and subject characteristics (e.g. sector subject area, level, framework/standard name).

The <u>Further education and skills statistics: methodology</u> document published alongside the main release should be referenced alongside this data. It provides information on the data sources, their coverage and quality as well as explaining methodology used in producing the data.

#### Underlying data - apprenticeship vacancies

This dataset comprises apprenticeship advert and vacancy content supplied by recruiters and published on the <u>Find An Apprenticeship</u> digital service.

The service is operated by the Department for Education as a recruitment platform, free at point of use. It enables:

- Employers to publicise apprenticeship vacancies.
- Candidates to apply for vacancies.
- Recruiters to manage the recruitment process for the vacancies displayed on the service.

A Vacancy is defined as a single opportunity for a unique individual to be employed as an Apprentice. A single advertisement (previously referred to as a Vacancy Notice) may contain one or more Vacancies.

The dataset comprises the items listed below. All standard fields are populated using a standardised selection of data items, some are automatically system-populated. The content of free text fields is drafted by the author of an advertisement and is not restricted by the system. Please note that any apprenticeships arising as a result of the vacancy must comply with apprenticeship funding rules.


# Annex B – quick guide to using the underlying files on Explore Education Statistics

Navigate to the 'Explore data and files' section of the release to find several useful underlying and supporting files for the data on the publication.

The underlying data files and metadata specification can be found under the 'All supporting files' sections. Once expanded you will see a list of all the files available for you to download and use.

Due to the size of some of these files follow these steps to download and access the data.


Click the data file link you wish to view; this will automatically start a download of the file through your internet browser. Once this step is complete, click the file, or open your downloads folder on your file explorer.




The data files will download as CSV files which you can create a connection to and build a pivot table for your analysis.

Save the file from the downloads folder into a suitable location of your choice.


In excel on the 'Data' tab click the 'From Text/CSV' button in the top ribbon of excel.

## Select the option to 'Load to'




At the next stage it will open an 'import data' window.



Select 'PivotTable Report'. Whilst the data is loading you will see the queries and connections to the right side of the excel process the pivot table – bigger files can take a while.



Once this is complete the pivots tables will be ready for you to manipulate in whichever way is required.



**Top tip!** When creating a pivot table from a large dataset tick 'defer layout update' until you have finished building your pivot options.
