Description

This document describes the data included in the 'Children accommodated in secure children's homes, 2020' National Statistics release's underlying data files. This data is released under the terms of the Open Government License and is intended to meet at least 3 stars for Open Data.

- · placement type.

The information is based on aggregate data collected from each secure children's home.
