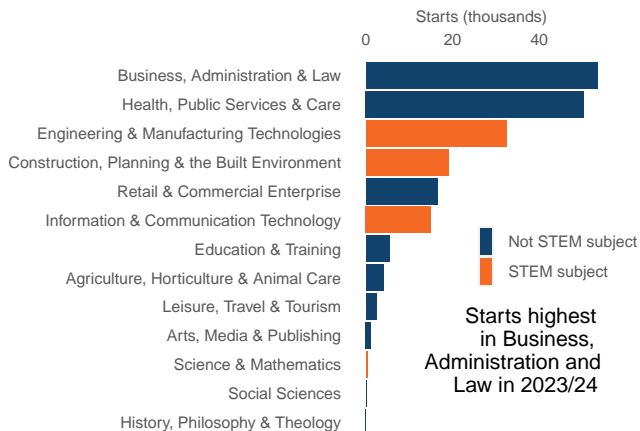
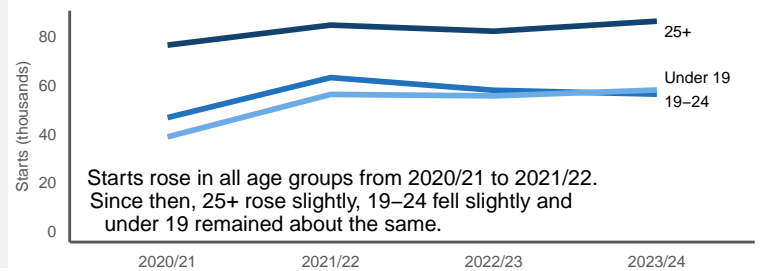
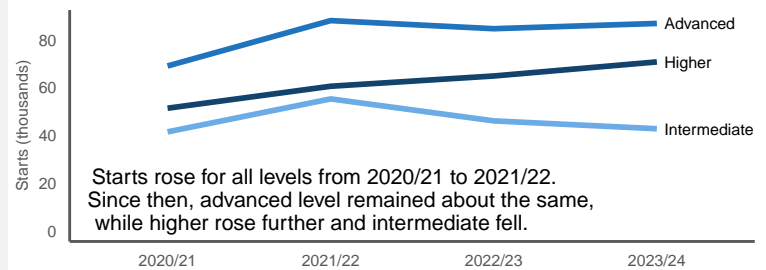

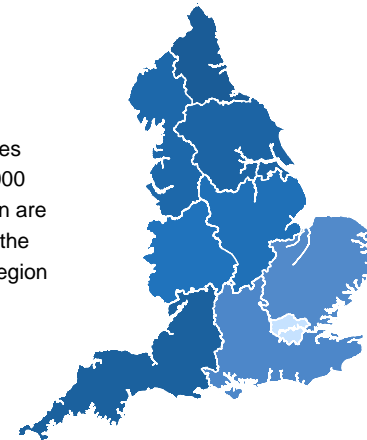

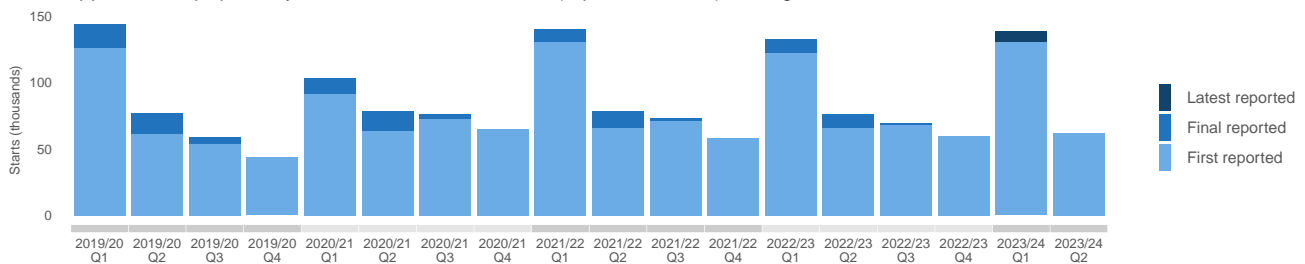

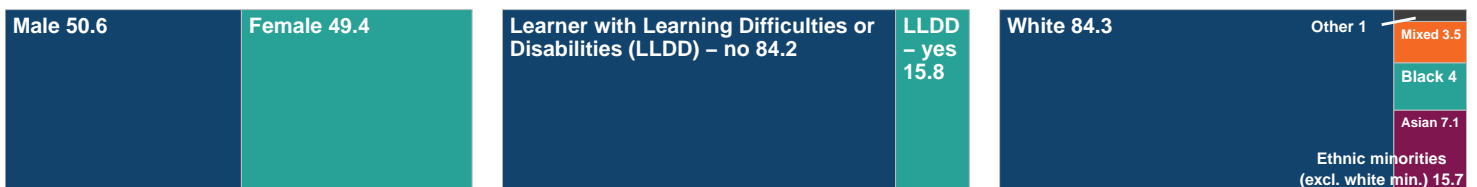
Starts rates per 100,000 population are lowest in the London region
