Description

This document describes the additional supporting files that accompany the 'Apprenticeships: May 2024' statistics publication. This data is released under the terms of the [Open Government License](#). It is provided to allow users to interrogate the data themselves.

The underlying data files contain apprenticeship starts, achievements and participation figures in England; broken down by learner characteristics (e.g. age, sex, ethnicity group), geography (e.g. region, local authority district) and subject characteristics (e.g. sector subject area, level, framework/standard name).

Annex B – Notes for interpreting the underlying data for the public sector apprenticeship return dataset

1. Sub sector is allocated based on a mapping of Apprenticeship Service account (ASA) names to public sector bodies.
2. Staff in schools maintained by a Local Authority are included within the total figures for the Local Authority. For 2022-23, Local Authorities were also able to provide separate figures for staff in schools. There are three rows of data for the Local Authorities that supplied separate figures – one covering maintained schools only, one excluding maintained schools and a total for all staff.
3. New apprentices include employees who were already working for the body before beginning their apprenticeship, as well as new apprentice hires.
4. Several bodies have not been included in national and sub-sector average. Possible reasons for exclusion are listed below: i) they had fewer than 250 employees at the start of the reporting period and are therefore out of scope for the collection in that period ii) they have not been identified as a public sector body through internal mapping of Apprenticeship Service Accounts. iii) the total number of apprentices declared at the start or end of the reporting period is greater than or equal to the overall reported headcount for the same period.

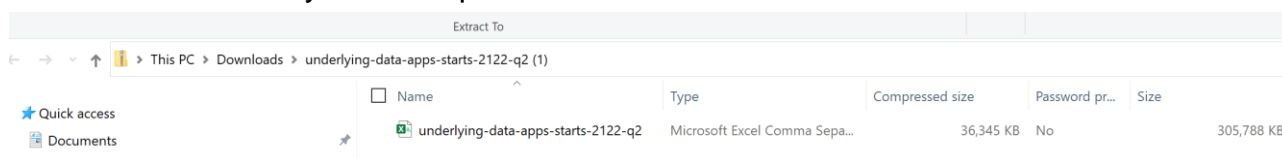
Annex C – quick guide to using the underlying files on EES (EXPLORE EDUCATION STATISTICS)

Navigate to the 'Explore data and files' section of the release to find several useful underlying and supporting files for the data on the publication.

The underlying data files and meta data information can be found under the 'All supporting files' sections. Once expanded you will see a list of all the files available for you to download and use.

Due to the size of some of these files follow these steps to download and access the data.

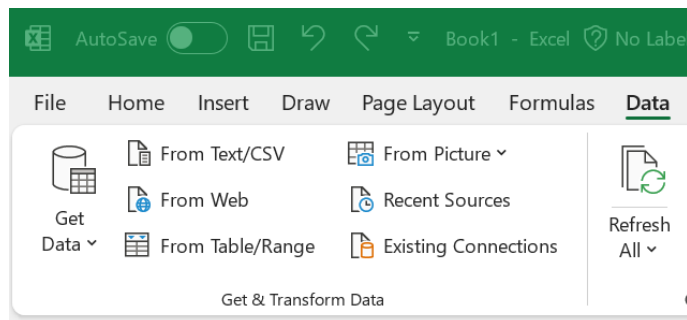
Click the data file link you wish to view; this will automatically start a download of the file through your internet browser. Once this step is complete, click the file, or open your downloads folder on your file explorer.



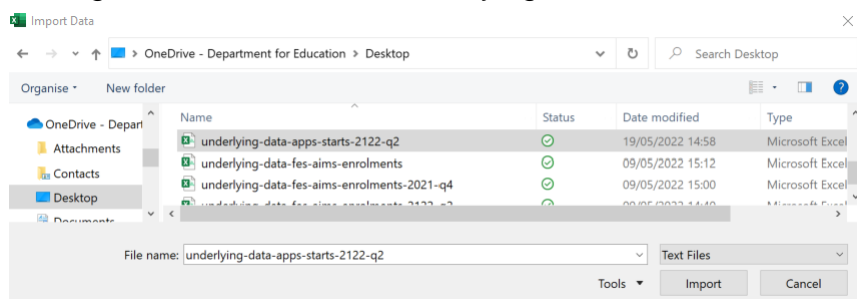
The data files will download as CSV files which you can create a connection to and build a pivot table for your analysis.

Save the file from the downloads folder into a suitable location of your choice.

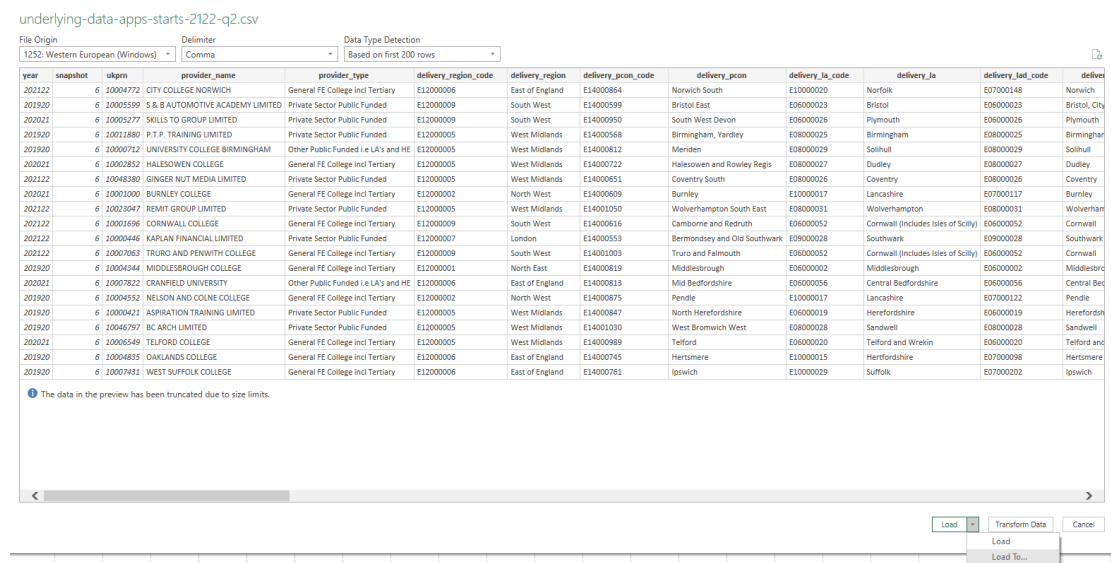
In excel on the 'Data' tab click the 'From Text/CSV' button in the top ribbon of excel.



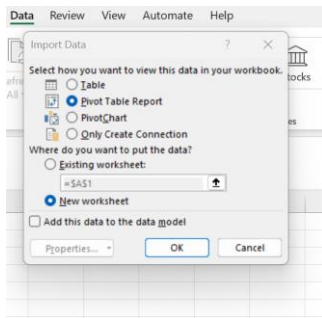
Navigate to the folder the underlying file is saved to and select the file to 'import'



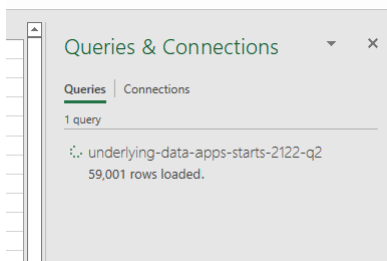
Select the option to 'Load to'



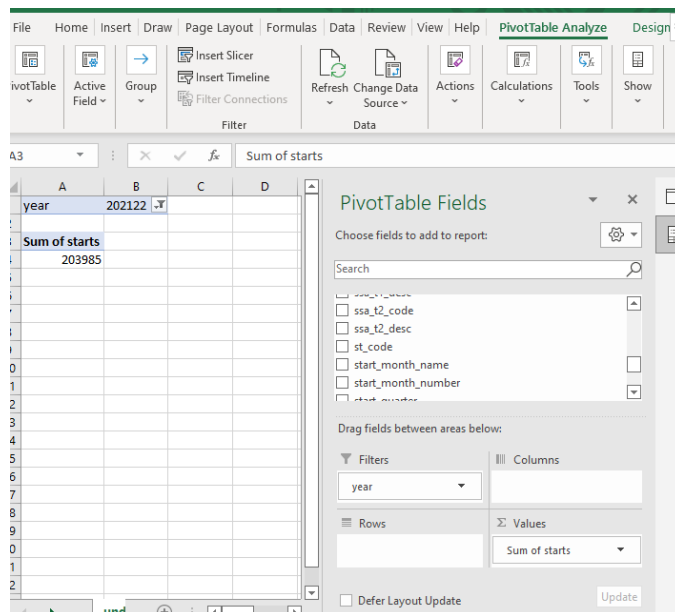
At the next stage it will open an 'import data' window.



Select 'PivotTable Report'. Whilst the data is loading you will see the queries and connections to the right side of the excel process the pivot table – bigger files can take a while.



Once this is complete the pivots tables will be ready for you to manipulate in whichever way is required.



Top tip! When creating a pivot table from a large dataset tick 'defer layout update' until you have finished building your pivot options.
