Description

This document describes the data included in the 'Children accommodated in secure children's homes, 2019' National Statistics release's underlying data files. This data is released under the terms of the <u>Open Government License</u> and is intended to meet at least 3 stars for <u>Open Data</u>.

The publication methodology document should be referenced alongside this data. It provides information on the data sources, their coverage and quality as well as explaining methodology used in producing the data.

Coverage

This release includes information on the numbers of children accommodated in secure children's homes in England and Wales.

It includes information on:

- numbers of places approved for and available for use
- numbers of children accommodated
- age
- gender
- length of stay
- placement type.

The information is based on aggregate data collected from each secure children's home.
