

Participation in education, training and employment age 16 to 21

Supporting file metadata: 16-18 participation by provider, FSM and region (for those educated in England state-sector at 15)

Description

This document describes the additional supporting file '16-18 participation by provider, FSM and region'. The data gives numbers participating at ages 16, 17 and 18 in education and apprenticeships of those educated in the England state-sector at 15. This accompanies the 'Participation in education, training and employment age 16 to 21' statistics publication.

This data also contains participation figures by provider type, region and Free School Meal (FSM) status.

Region is based on the postcode of the institution at each age. This differs from the underlying data presented in the main commentary which uses local authority at age 15.
